Our Environmentally Responsible Funds

The Green Century MSCI International Index Fund is a passively managed mutual fund that invests in companies in all developed markets outside of the U.S. It is one of the first environmentally responsible, fossil fuel free international index funds available to U.S. investors.

The Green Century Equity Fund is a passively managed mutual fund that invests in U.S.-based companies and follows a customized version of one of the longest-running sustainability indexes.

The Green Century Balanced Fund is an actively managed mutual fund that invests primarily in U.S. stocks and bonds, with more than 60% of fixed income holdings in green bonds.
